Proposed amendments to Special Event Vehicles Conditions

It is proposed the conditions outline below are placed on stretched limousines:

	ISSUE	PROPOSED AMENDMENT	JUSTIFICATION
1	Fire Extinguisher & First Aid Kit	The vehicle must contain a fully functional portable multipurpose powder type fire extinguisher, which bears a kite mark and is tested and installed in accordance with HSE requirements. The vehicle must also carry a HSE approved First Aid Kit.	For the safety of the vehicle occupants (required under existing PHV conditions).
2	Alcohol	If passengers are under the age of 18, there should be no alcohol in the vehicle for consumption or otherwise.	For the protection of children from harm
3	Entertainment	The licence holder shall not supply any media that, given its age classification or content, is unsuitable for the age of the passengers in the vehicle.	To safeguard child passengers from viewing unsuitable material.
4	Entertainment	The licence holder shall ensure that a performing rights licence is held where appropriate	Many limousines have the capability of playing recorded media for the entertainment of customers and are required to hold a performing rights licence.
5	Seat Belts	Seatbelts must be fitted to all seats and must be worn at all times by passengers whilst the vehicle is in motion.	For the safety of passengers.
6	Advertisements	No other signs, notices or any other markings will be displayed on or in the vehicle without the written permission of the council	To ensure that any material displayed in the limousine does not affect the safety or comfort of passengers. Permission from the Council will not be unreasonably withheld.
7	Fog machines, lasers, fibre optics, disco balls, Jacuzzis	Use should comply with relevant Health and Safety regulations and should not be used in a manner, which is likely to distract the limousine driver or other road users.	To ensure public safety.
8	Strobe Lights	Where strobe lights are to be used, those hiring the vehicle should be verbally notified in advance and the person making the booking notified both verbally and in writing. Strobe lighting should not be used/be turned off if so requested. Use should comply with relevant	To ensure public safety.
