

Dear Sir Madam

I understand the Council intend to issue penalty points to Taxis who drop off passengers on their own taxi rank or stop in bus stops. This leaves no practical stopping point for Taxis in March town centre.

Local licensing authorities will also be aware that the public should have reasonable access to taxi and PHV services - Licensing requirements which are unduly stringent will tend unreasonably to restrict the supply of taxi and PHV services." The council are in affect denying the public the opportunity to use Taxi's to come to the town centre, or if wishing to book a Taxi to get home forcing the public, many elderly and frail with walking frames, to haul several bags of shopping out of the town centre to allow a Taxi to stop and collect them.
