<u>LIC6/20</u> REVIEW OF LICENSING STATEMENT OF POLICY DOCUMENT - LICENSING ACT 2003 FOLLOWING RESPONSES RECEIVED DURING CONSULTATION.

Members considered the Review of Licensing Statement of Policy Document – Licensing Act 2003 report following responses received during consultation presented by Michelle Bishop.

Members AGREED to recommend to Full Council that the draft Statement of Licensing Policy be approved for the period of 2021 - 2026.

LIC7/20 REVIEW OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE LICENSING POLICY.

Members considered the Review of Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Policy report presented by Michelle Bishop.

Councillor Hoy commented that it would be useful in future to see what the difference is in our policy between items that we must have by law under Licensing Acts and items that we include as an addition.
