New Application for a Street Trading Consent under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.

Application considered

The Sub-Committee heard an application for the renewal of a street trading consent to Mr E Tasci.

Law and guidance considered

Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, Schedule 4; and Fenland District Council's Street Trading Consent Policy 2025

Legal advice provided

That there were no objections to the application and whilst Mr Tasci would be afforded the right to speak, it was up to him whether he wished to.

Matters found to be irrelevant

None.

Decision

To grant Mr Tasci's street trading consent as applied for.

Reasons for the decision

There were no objections to the application, and the Sub-Committee noted Mr Tasci's history of trading and upkeep of the location.
