| Report Title: | PROPOSED INCREASE TO CURRENT HACKNEY CARRIAGE <br> VEHICLE TABLE OF FARES |

## 1 Purpose / Summary

- To adopt the proposed increase of the Hackney Carriage Vehicle Table of Fares.


## 2 Key issues

- The Last Table of Fares increase was the 24 April 2012.
- Local Authorities have a power to set fares for hackney carriages under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.
- Request from the Taxi trade for an additional tariff was received by email on 05 August 2018
- On the 18th January 2019, Licensing Committee considered the request. All information relating to the request and the Committee discussion is found on the following link:

- Formal consultation was undertaken and ended on 31 March 2019.
- The Council received 16 responses to the proposed changes to the taxi tariff as outlined in the Table of Fares
- On the 25th April 2019, Licensing Committee met again to review and consider the responses received to the proposed increase in the Hackney carriage Table of Fares. All information relating to the request and the Committee discussion is found on the following link:

- Licensing Committee agreed that the proposed increase that went out to consultation should be implemented. In summary the increase to the trade will result in them being able to:
- Include Christmas Eve \& New Year's Eve as an enhanced rate.
- The Extra Charge for vehicles carrying 5-8 passengers will increase to 30p per person up to a maximum of $£ 1.20$. This is an increase from the current arrangement which is set at 20 p per person carrying $5-8$ passengers up to maximum of 80 p. However the Taxi trade can charge less than this amount if they would like to do so as the proposed charges are discretionary.


## Recommendations

- For Cabinet to approve the proposed Table of Fares as set out in Appendix B, and ratify the decision made by the Licensing Committee.

1 Background / introduction
The Council has 129 Licensed Drivers; 85 of these are Hackney Carriage Drivers, 30 are Private Hire Drivers and 14 are Dual Drivers. We currently have 130 Licensed Vehicles, 95 of these are Hackney Carriage and 35 are Private Hire. From the 95 Licensed Hackney Carriage vehicles we have 22 registered that are able to carry more than 4 passengers.
1.1 The fare structure currently in place was set by Licensing Committee on 24 April 2012 and shows 3 tariffs set for vehicles carrying a maximum of 4 passengers. There is an Extra Charge in place on this tariff for each person in excess of 4 passengers. This equates to 0.20 p per person to a maximum of 0.80 p.

The current tariff is at APPENDIX A
1.2 A licensed Hackney Carriage Driver wrote to the Council outlining a proposal for an additional tariff. The proposal outlines an additional tariff for vehicles carrying more than 4 passengers.
The request equated to a proposed increase of $50 \%$ for journeys undertaken on tariff 1 , $100 \%$ increase for tariff 2 and no change to tariff 3.
1.3 On 18 January 2019 Licensing Committee decided to not approve the requested additional tariff but they did approve an increase in the Table of Fares and the proposed tariff went out for consultation from 18 February 2019 until 31 March 2019. This is over the statutory 14 days. A copy of the proposed tariff agreed by the committee members for consultation can be seen at APPENDIX B. 1.4 On the 25th April 2019 Licensing Committee members discussed and reviewed responses on the proposed increased to the Table of Fares. They decided to go ahead with the proposed increase on the balance that if the trade wished to charge the increased amount they could but equally if they wished to charge a lower amount they would be able to.

- Hackney Carriage Drivers - 13
- Private Hire Drivers - 2
- Other persons (Hackney Carriage Proprietor) - 1

1.5 It is at the discretion of the Council as the Licensing Authority to set a Table of Fares for licensed Hackney Carriages operating within the district if it chooses to do so.

Councils are not obliged to set a maximum fare for their area, they could decide instead to rely on market forces to establish the going rate and at the same time promote competition. Comparisons with neighbouring authorities have taken place and are shown at APPENDIX D
1.6 It should be emphasised that any tariff set is the maximum any hackney carriage driver can charge. They are at liberty to charge less than the approved tariff if they choose to do so.
1.7 The tariff does not apply to private hire drivers who set their fares, via market forces, without Council involvement.

## 2 Legal Considerations

2.1 The authority for the Council to fix fares for hackney carriages is given under Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.

3 Financial Considerations
3.1 The cost of re-calibrating individual meters will be met by individual hackney carriage proprietors and the meters will then be checked by Licensing Officers as part of the compliance checks. This is a normal part of the work undertaken by Officers

## 4 Community impact

4.1 The District Council as the Licensing Authority has a duty to ensure that there is a safe, secure and confident 'taxi' service provided for the public.

## 5 Conclusions

5.1 That Cabinet approve the increase in the Hackney Carriage Table of Fares.
