ACTION 2 11/11/2019 OSC22/19	Councillor Cornwell asked for fly tipping figures to ascertain whether the introduction of licensing at household recycling centres by Cambs County Council has had any impact on the number of fly tipping incidents.	<p>The recent change has been the introduction of a permit scheme to focus on vans and commercial vehicles with the aim of reducing the levels of commercial and 'landlord type' waste being placed in the public waste stream and funded by council tax payers.</p> <p>The Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Waste Partnership (Recap) are monitoring the work and any changes across the County through their regular board meetings. It is too soon to identify any correlation but we will continue to monitor.</p>	Completed
