
Working with Fenland

The Partnership is collectively working towards a long-term strategic goal of Vision Zero, where there are no deaths and serious injuries on the Partnership's roads. This is an ambitious goal and will need time and effort to be achievable. With this Strategy starting in 2020, the goal is to move towards zero deaths or severe serious injuries in the Partnership area by 2040.







People make mistakes that can lead to road collisions.

The human body has a known, limited physical ability to tolerate collision forces before harm occurs.


While individuals have a responsibility to act with care and within traffic laws, a shared responsibility exists with those who design, build, manage and use roads and vehicles to prevent collisions resulting in serious injury or death and to provide post-collision care.

All parts of the system must be strengthened in combination to multiply their effects, and road users are still protected if one part fails.







