Statement of the Adoption of the Delivering and Protecting High Quality Environments in Fenland Supplementary Planning Document

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that Fenland District Council adopted the Delivering and Protecting High Quality Environments in Fenland Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) under the provisions of section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on 24 July 2014.

The SPD has been prepared to provide further guidance on a number of policies in the Fenland Local Plan 2014, and in particular Policy LP16 – "Delivering and Protecting High Quality Environments across the District". This will help developers in preparing planning applications for submission to Fenland District Council and help the Council to achieve high quality in new development.

The adopted version of the Delivering and Protecting High Quality Environments in Fenland SPD includes modifications made by the Council in the light of representations and for other minor changes which, taken together, do not materially affect the policies. All the modifications made since the publication of the Consultation Version of the SPD (January 2014) are included in the report on the consultation which is available to view on the Council's website and at locations listed below.
