Chapter 8 of the NPPF provides the context for assessing associated health matters, and an appropriately worded policy in the emerging Local Plan could provide guidance on these matters for most development. It is considered that a Health Impact Assessment should only be required for the largest developments (e.g. +250 dwellings). If the threshold is too low it would be an unnecessary burden on applicants to prepare an assessment and for Council officers (in Planning and Environmental Health) to review the assessment. In our experience the Health Impact Assessment has no influence on the decision-making process for planning applications.

Planning policies need to take a proactive and preventative approach, particularly focused on the wider determinants of health (such as housing, the economy, access to green/open space, transport) and ensuring children have the best start in life, as well as supporting healthy lifestyles and reducing health inequalities.

50032-17 Yes, the concentration of hot food takeaways is a continuing area of concern for communities in terms of the impact on the retail character and economic health of town centres and the adverse impacts on the amenity of residents associated with noise, fumes, parking, litter and anti-social behaviour and more recently this has extended to health issues, concerning poor diet and obesity.

Evidence shows the local food environment is an important factor in unhealthy weight specifically the availability of unhealthy food. Some hot food takeaways offer 'energy-dense' or 'fast food' with high levels of fat, sugar and salt which are linked to obesity and related health conditions including cardiovascular disease, type 2 diabetes, stroke and some cancers. Of particular concern is the effect of fast food consumption on children's diets and eating behaviour, as significant health problems related to obesity start to develop at primary school age and behaviours established in early life follow into adulthood.

A proliferation of hot food takeaways can tempt children into consuming greater quantities of unhealthy food which undermines initiatives to promote a healthy diet, particularly in schools. Temptation to eat fast food is only partly influenced by the availability and accessibility of hot food takeaway outlets, but also by other factors which influence eating behaviour, such as advertising, marketing, economics, and peer group pressure. Nevertheless, some takeaways located near schools may target school children by selling foods within their price range and offer special deals.

There is a strong relationship between spatial planning and the wider determinants of health, and the planning system can shape the built environment and therefore influence human behaviour and lifestyles. In response to obesity, planning can help to:

☑ Improve healthier eating choices and opportunities for urban growing. ☑ Promote physical activity by encouraging active travel and improving access to open spaces and sports and recreation facilities.

A quick review of other local authorities local plans and SPDs show that many have introduced specific policies to control hot food takeaway outlets, so this approach has been tested through the planning system and a precedent has been set to control the proliferation of hot food takeaways through the planning system

It needs to be recognised that the proposal to introduce a policy on hot food takeaways is not about stopping all outlets and that it won't address those outlets already in existence, but is about controlling the location of future hot food takeaway outlets to prevent them locating near schools, and prevent an over dominance of outlets in certain locations.

Public Health would be willing to work with the Fenland District Council on the exact wording of such a policy.

Spatial planning and development has the potential to impact on human health and wellbeing. This is because a wide range of social and environmental factors affect the health of local communities within Fenland. Good health is related to good quality housing and developments, well designed street scenes, well laid out neighbourhoods, quality and efficiency in transport systems, opportunities to experience leisure and cultural services activities and green and open space. These factors are known as the "wider determinants of health" and include: 1. Individual lifestyle factors such as smoking habits, diet and physical activity. 2. Interactions with friends, relatives and mutual support within a community. 3. Wider influences on health including - living and working conditions, unemployment, water and sanitation, health care service, housing, food supplies, education, and the work environment.

Ensuring these issues are considered at the planning and design stage can improve both the physical and mental health of the population. These can encourage environments which: increase people's sense of safety and wellbeing, their opportunities for social interaction and community connectivity, improve air quality and water conservation and promote active travel and physical activity.

It is important to consider the effects of the wider determinants of health on not only the physical environment (e.g. impact of air and noise pollution, traffic patterns, housing stock) but also the social environment. This refers broadly to the social norms and values shared by members of social groups, as well as the quality, content, and volume of interpersonal interactions within urban and rural and between urban and rural communities. It is also known that these wider determinants are not distributed equally among populations (e.g. those people living in areas of deprivation tend to have poorer health outcomes). By considering these effects and their distribution, development policies and plans can enhance the potential to influence health and wellbeing, and therefore health inequalities.

Health Impact Assessment aims to identify all these effects on health in order to enhance the benefits for health and minimise any risks to health. It includes specifically a consideration of the differential impacts on different groups in the population, because certain groups are potentially more vulnerable to negative impacts from development such as those on a low income, people involved in the criminal justice system, minority ethnic groups, young, disabled (physically and learning) and elderly people.

Therefore the Fenland Local Plan should contain a policy requiring developers of large schemes to submit a health impact assessment. Public Health would be willing to work with the Fenland District Council on the exact wording of such a policy.

In our experience the Health Impact Assessment has no influence on the decision-making process for planning applications.

50034-16 Yes we believe it is vital that the Local Plan includes specific policies about health and wellbeing and as per the National Planning Policy Guidance (NPPF) we should expect the local plan to address the recommendations in the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy that is currently being developed for Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.

In addition the local plan should take account of the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Director of Public Health annual report. Planning policies need to take a proactive and preventative approach, particularly focused on the wider determinants of health (such as housing, the economy, access to green/open space, transport) and ensuring children have the best start in life, as well as supporting healthy lifestyles and reducing health inequalities.

7b) Do you think the Local Plan should include a policy to restrict the amount, or location of, hot food takeaways?

50034-17 Yes, the concentration of hot food takeaways is a continuing area of concern for communities in terms of the impact on the retail character and economic health of town centres and the adverse impacts on the amenity of residents associated with noise, fumes, parking, litter and anti-social behaviour and more recently this has extended to health issues, concerning poor diet and obesity.

Evidence shows the local food environment is an important factor in unhealthy weight specifically the availability of unhealthy food. Some hot food takeaways offer 'energy-dense' or 'fast food' with high levels of fat, sugar and salt which are linked to obesity and related health conditions including cardiovascular disease, type 2 diabetes, stroke and some cancers. Of particular concern is the effect of fast food consumption on children's diets and eating behaviour, as significant health problems related to obesity start to develop at primary school age and behaviours established in early life follow into adulthood.

A proliferation of hot food takeaways can tempt children into consuming greater quantities of unhealthy food which undermines initiatives to promote a healthy diet, particularly in schools. Temptation to eat fast food is only partly influenced by the availability and accessibility of hot food takeaway outlets, but also by other factors which influence eating behaviour, such as advertising, marketing, economics, and peer group pressure. Nevertheless, some takeaways located near schools may target school children by selling foods within their price range and offer special deals.

There is a strong relationship between spatial planning and the wider determinants of health, and the planning system can shape the built environment and therefore influence human behaviour and lifestyles. In response to obesity, planning can help to:

☑ Improve healthier eating choices and opportunities for urban growing. ☑ Promote physical activity by encouraging active travel and improving access to open spaces and sports and recreation facilities.

A quick review of other local authorities local plans and SPDs show that many have introduced specific policies to control hot food takeaway outlets, so this approach has been tested through the planning system and a precedent has been set to control the proliferation of hot food takeaways through the planning system

It needs to be recognised that the proposal to introduce a policy on hot food takeaways is not about stopping all outlets and that it won't address those outlets already in existence, but is about controlling the location of future hot food takeaway outlets to prevent them locating near schools, and prevent an over dominance of outlets in certain locations.

Public Health would be willing to work with the Fenland District Council on the exact wording of such a policy.

Spatial planning and development has the potential to impact on human health and wellbeing. This is because a wide range of social and environmental factors affect the health of local communities within Fenland. Good health is related to good quality housing and developments, well designed street scenes, well laid out neighbourhoods, quality and efficiency in transport systems, opportunities to experience leisure and cultural services activities and green and open space. These factors are known as the "wider determinants of health" and include: Individual lifestyle factors such as smoking habits, diet and physical activity. Interactions with friends, relatives and mutual support within a community. Wider influences on health including - living and working conditions, unemployment, water and sanitation, health care service, housing, food supplies, education, and the work environment.

Ensuring these issues are considered at the planning and design stage can improve both the physical and mental health of the population. These can encourage environments which: increase people's sense of safety and wellbeing, their opportunities for social interaction and community connectivity, improve air quality and water conservation and promote active travel and physical activity.

It is important to consider the effects of the wider determinants of health on not only the physical environment (e.g. impact of air and noise pollution, traffic patterns, housing stock) but also the social environment. This refers broadly to the social norms and values shared by members of social groups, as well as the quality, content, and volume of interpersonal interactions within urban and rural and between urban and rural communities. It is also known that these wider determinants are not distributed equally among populations (e.g. those people living in areas of deprivation tend to have poorer health outcomes). By considering these effects and their distribution, development policies and plans can enhance the potential to influence health and wellbeing, and therefore health inequalities.

Health Impact Assessment aims to identify all these effects on health in order to enhance the benefits for health and minimise any risks to health. It includes specifically a consideration of the differential impacts on different groups in the population, because certain groups are potentially more vulnerable to negative impacts from development such as those on a low income, people involved in the criminal justice system, minority ethnic groups, young, disabled (physically and learning) and elderly people.

Therefore the Fenland Local Plan should contain a policy requiring developers of large schemes to submit a health impact assessment.
