The civic society believes that towns in The Fens have a unique set of characteristics in terms of layout, building design and character. This stems from the nature of The Fens' history prior to drainage, the architecture that was inspired by those who drained The Fens, and the fact that The Fens is a peaceful, green, open area of countryside.

As such, we believe that having strong guidelines around design would help the area to maintain this distinctive character.

13b) Do you think there is a need for different local design policies for each individual town and / or village?

There is a marked difference between towns such as Chatteris, which has experienced limited growth until now and retains strong historic appeal throughout, to areas such as Wisbech which have experienced more growth of newer, more industrialised areas.

As such, it might be appropriate to have different policies for different towns, and even different areas of each town. For example, new infill housing in the centre of an historic market town may require different standards of design to a brand new development on the outskirts of an already growing town.

50024-32 13c) Are there any specific local issues which need to be addressed through design policies?

We think that areas of concern in Chatteris are a lack of accessible green spaces and natural green spaces for members of the public, an inadequate number and variety of trees, a lack of amenities (limited shopping options, a constrained GP surgery, no NHS dental provision, no public swimming pool, etc) and insufficient infrastructure (especially in terms of transport).

50024-33 13d) Should the Local Plan require developers to use national toolkits, such as Building for Life?

Our organisation's remit says that we "Encourage high standards in the management and development of the built and natural environment in the Chatteris area". We think that requiring developers to use one of these frameworks is a good idea to help achieve high quality developments.

Some of these toolkits have had input from Civic Societies nationally. In particular, Chatteris Past, Present & Future made a donation to "Civic Voice" - a national grouping of Civic Societies - to support their work in providing input to the "Building Better, Building Beautiful" framework.
