20a) Do you agree that the Local Plan should strengthen the role of town centres to encourage people to shop and visit?

Yes. We believe that the town centres are the beating heart of the community. They foster a sense of community spirit and engagement, and really help people to feel as though they "live" in the town rather than just sleep here.

We think that the town centres should be managed according to a principle of bringing people together. This could include more open spaces, more places and facilities for people to relax and spend their free time and more spaces for people to work and collaborate together.
