

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations 2022

- Notice is hereby given that Fenland District Council is conducting a review of those polling districts, polling places and polling stations for Fenland District area of the North East Cambridgeshire Parliamentary Constituency due to an electoral review of Fenland by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England.
- 2. Details of the existing arrangements and the Returning Officer's proposals for the changes will form the basis of this review.
- 3. Any elector within the District may make representations concerning either the existing, or proposed arrangements as to their accessibility with regard to all electors within a particular polling district.
- 4. The Council particularly welcomes any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to comment on the Council's proposals, or those recommendations of the Returning Officer.
- 5. The Council's proposals will be published on 28 September 2022 and all comments are to be received by 11 November 2022.
- 6. Any representations should be addressed to the Electoral Services Officer; they will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at the Electoral Registration Office, Fenland Hall, County Road, March Cambs PE15 8NQ. A list of those persons or bodies making a representation will be published on the Council's website www.fenland.gov.uk
- 7. Where possible representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
- 8. Final recommendations will be considered by the Council at its meeting on 12 December 2022 and implementation of the results will take effect for the elections taking place on 4 May 2023.
