Plastic pots, tubs and trays

Yoghurt pots

Glass bottles and jars (if broken just place
 in the blue bin, don't wrap them)

Tinfoil

Aerosol cans

Shredded paper

Plant pots

Medication tablet packets (Blister packs)

Cigarettes

Wet wipes

Cling film

Bubble wrap

Animal waste

Tea bags

Coffee pods

Elastic bands

Contact lenses and pouches

Vacuum cleaner dust and bags

*The Scrunch Test – Scrunch your wrappers into a ball, if they remain in a ball they can be recycled and placed in the blue bin. If they pop open, they cannot be recycled and will need to go in the green bin.
